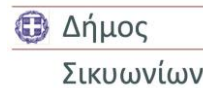

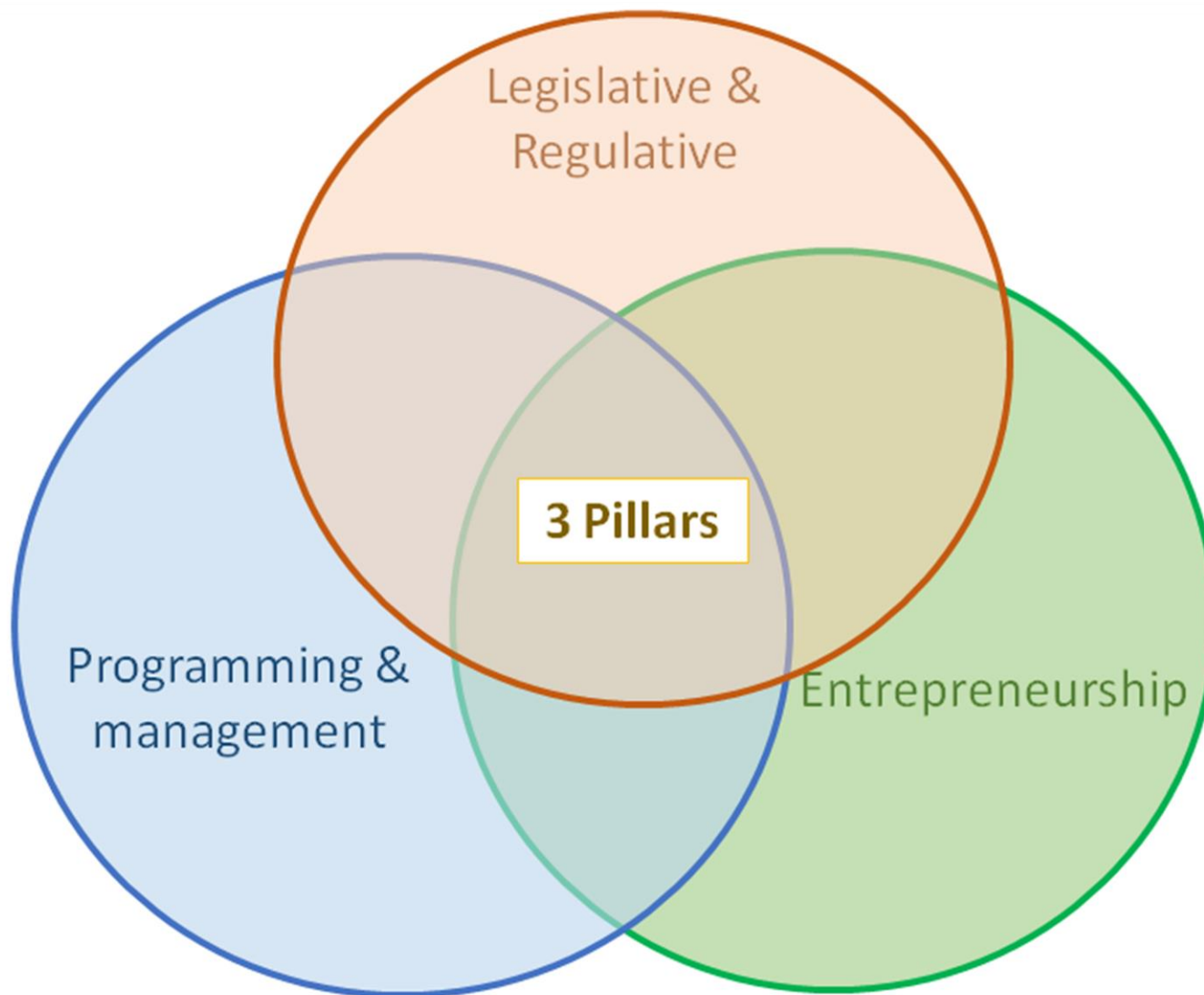

- New Policies in which the institutional and regulatory framework will be redesigned with the positive influence of entrepreneurship. The economic viability of the management plan will be an important component.
- Prioritized Action Framework 2014-2020: Under the current conditions of economic and social crisis, Natura 2000 sites should be part of the solution or else they will be subject to extremely severe degradation pressures.
- Management Authorities: with possibilities of business partnerships and initiatives. Intersections in the institutional framework and promotion of the management through management contracts from social economy structures (e.g. Social Cooperative Enterprises) or private structures.
- Management Plans with Business Plans in order to Finance Management.

- ❑ Prioritized Action Framework 2014-2020: Financing the management of the Natura 2000 network by combining different financial instruments and tools. Central level – Ministry of Environment.
- ❑ Integrated Territory Investments (ITI): ITI UNESCO Crete (Biosphere Reserves & Geoparks). Region of Crete.
- ❑ Planning to support business innovation: Biosphere Reserve and Business Innovation Zones in the Eastern Peloponnese - Biosphere Reserve Mount Parnonas & Cape Malea. Local Level, Municipalities and Development Company of Parnon and Peloponnese

- Private and Public Sector Partnerships - Private Sector and Protected Areas Management Authorities Partnerships.
- Business initiatives in protected areas.
- Activate business dynamics through private finance, banking products etc.
